YOUR PRESCRIPTION DRUG PROGRAM

Security Health Plan has chosen SXC Health Solutions, Inc. to administer the medical supply portion of your plan, as well as potentially saving you money on your prescription drugs.

You will find using your Security Health Plan ID card an easy and convenient way to obtain your ostomy and diabetic supplies and some medications. The following guidelines should answer many of the questions you may have.

How Do I Use My Membership Card for Prescriptions?

Your Security Health Plan member ID card will be accepted at pharmacies that are part of our SXC Health Solutions' local and chain pharmacy network. You must present your card along with your prescription at any one of the network pharmacies in your area. Diabetic and ostomy supplies will be covered according to your benefit. Prescription drugs will be provided at contracted prices which may be lower than what you are paying now.

How Do I Find a Network Pharmacy?

You'll find a participating network pharmacy close to your home or place of work. SXC Health Solutions' local and chain pharmacy network includes approximately 45,000 pharmacy locations nationwide. To locate the pharmacy nearest you, call Security Health Plan at **1-800-472-2363**.

What Types of Drugs Are Not Subject to Security Value Pricing?

This is a partial list. Please consult your Plan materials for a complete list of exclusions to your discount drug plan. In general, the following are not covered:

- Over-the-counter medication unless indicated by Security Health Plan
- Drugs used for cosmetic purposes
- Weight management drugs
- Drugs used to enhance athletic ability
- Investigational and experimental drugs
- Any medication that does not have an FDA indication
- Early refills (before 60% of original prescription is used)

Please note: Security Value pricing is only available from the pharmacy at the time your prescription is filled.

How Can I Save Money On My Prescriptions?

Go Generic! Are generic drugs as effective as brand name drugs? Almost always, the answer is yes. When you need a new prescription, ask your doctor whether a generic can be substituted for a brand name. If your doctor gives the "OK" for the generic substitute, generally the pharmacist will charge you a lesser amount for your prescription. Over several refills, the savings can really add up. If you're currently taking a brand name prescription, ask your doctor if a generic drug would work as well. If so, you can start saving money with your next refill.

Coordination of Benefits

If any family members have other insurance coverage that has been determined by Security Health Plan to be their primary insurance, that company will be responsible to pay for the ostomy and diabetic supplies and some medications. Call Security Health Plan at 1-800-472-2363 to obtain a claim form to submit pharmacy claims.

You must include a copy of the Explanation of Benefits (EOB) and a detailed pharmacy receipt. Any claim form submitted without an EOB from the primary company will be denied.
